
POLL: 57.3% LIKELY VOTERS BELIEVE ELECTION FRAUD PLAYED “SIGNIFICANT” OR “VERY SIGNIFICANT” ROLE IN BIDEN’S 2020 ELECTION

This Represents a 4.3% Increase from July to August
Another 11.9% are “Unsure” = 69.2%

SARASOTA, FL — Since April 2021, skepticism has grown among likely voters regarding the November 2020 Presidential Election results. Many likely voters believe that election integrity affected the results of the 2020 elections. Through the efforts of a large group of citizens, organizations and a handful of elected officials, more and more information from different states is being brought to light, putting into question the reliability of our election process.

In recent weeks, reports regarding ballot harvesting in Georgia, a preliminary hearing of the Arizona Senate’s election audit of Maricopa County (Phoenix), and yesterday’s Maricopa canvass report (*Bannon’s War Room: Seth Keshel, America Project, Research Analyst*) showing a minimum of 300,000 to 400,000 rigged votes (15%-20% of all Maricopa votes) from a combination of ballot stuffing to ballot destruction, are just some of the examples that have called the reliability of our election processes into question.

“Election integrity is the fabric of our constitution. November 2020 elections were tampered with in many counties across the nation. The truth is rising and rising fast...and no one can hide from it,” Lt. General Michael Flynn (ret.), Senior Strategic Advisor at The America Project.

The poll also highlighted some additional key takeaways:

- Only 37.7% of respondents believe the 2022 mid-term elections will be fair.
- Only 32.3% say it is very unlikely any fraud occurred in Maricopa County, AZ.
- Only 25.2% Approve or Strongly Approve of President Biden's handling of Afghanistan.

This poll of likely voters on these issues has been conducted regularly since April 2021. The poll posed several timely questions to likely voters, the first being consistent across all five months. **“Election integrity issues affected the outcome of the 2020 US Presidential Election in a way that was: Not Significant, Significant, Very Significant, Unsure”.**

The poll sampled approximately 2,166 likely voters with weighting methods, where permitted by data, were used to match with demographic groupings determined by the US Census Bureau.
